
It was a very good start for our project.

We have to mention also the workshops held by Francisco and Theresa Pacheco, also by Pablo, we highly felt the instructor's encouragement of creativity and were able to express ourself freely. At the end we have to mention how welcoming and hospitable the hosting families were; overall, we- teachers and students- had a wonderful experience.









#### WHILE THE ITALIANS...

Loaded with luggage, six students and two teachers, prepare to board the aircraft in the direction of Oporto's Sa Carneiro airport. We look forward to meeting those who will accompany us on what promises to be a fantastic experience shared with Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish and Polish learners and teachers.



This is the logbook they gave us during the opening celebration of the Erasmus project 'Let's Discover Arts': Portuguese primary school pupils welcomed us with a song about water, a fundamental element in Portuguese history between explorers and colonial experience.





Then some explanation from the Bioria park guides on the local fauna and flora, including medicinal plants used to cure the wounds of pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostela and the 'flamingo', a pink flamingo with an extraordinary wingspan, symbol of the nature park itself. The part on the migrations of some bird species between Africa and Portugal is very interesting.
